

Adventure Club Rules & Regulations

Objective:

To promote outdoor activities, team spirit, and personal development through adventurous experiences, while ensuring the safety and well-being of all members.

1. Membership

- **Eligibility:** Open to all students of NUR International University with an interest in outdoor activities.
- **Application:** Interested students must complete a membership form and attend an introductory meeting.
- **Commitment:** Members are expected to participate in a minimum number of activities each semester.

2. Conduct

- **Safety First:** Members must prioritize safety during all activities and adhere to the instructions provided by organizers and guides.
- **Respect for Nature:** Members must respect the environment, follow Leave No Trace principles, and ensure that no harm comes to wildlife or natural surroundings.
- **Teamwork:** Members must work together, support each other, and maintain a positive attitude during all activities.

3. Meetings

- **Attendance:** Attendance at pre-trip meetings is mandatory to discuss safety, logistics, and other important details.
- **Preparation:** Members must come prepared for meetings and activities, with the necessary gear and equipment.
- **Communication:** Members must stay informed through the club's communication channels for updates and announcements.

4. Trip Planning & Participation

- **Approval:** All trips and activities must be approved by the club's executive committee and the university administration.
